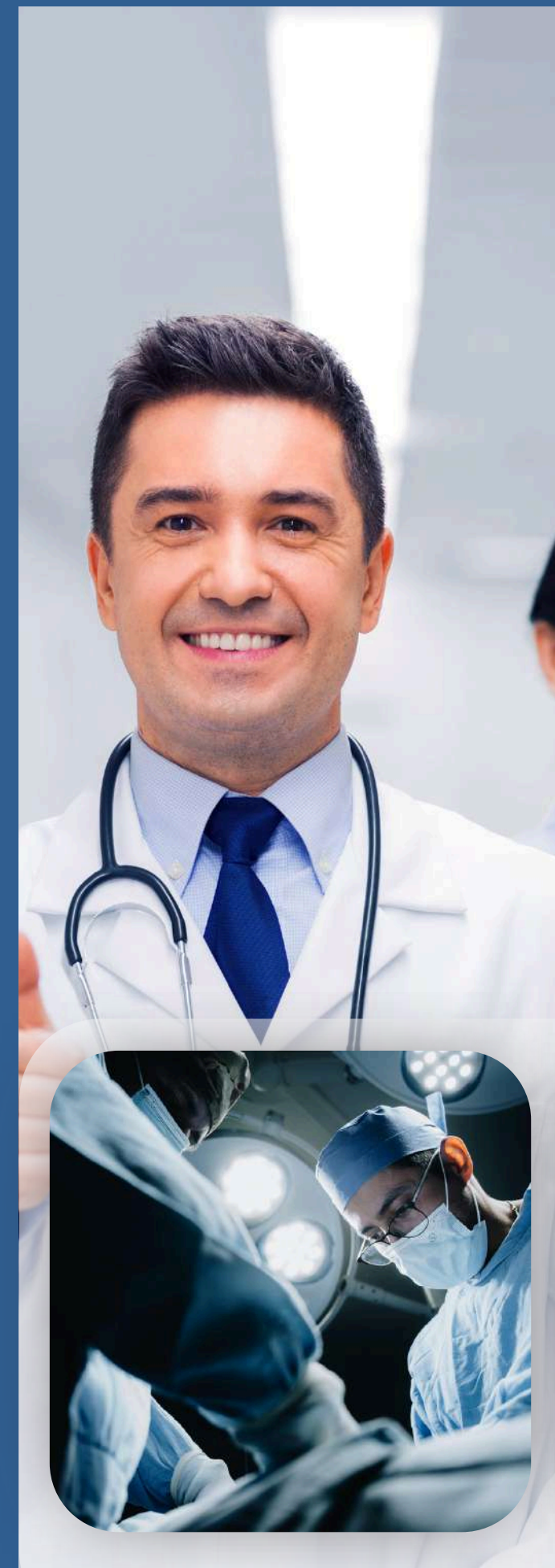

Program Objective

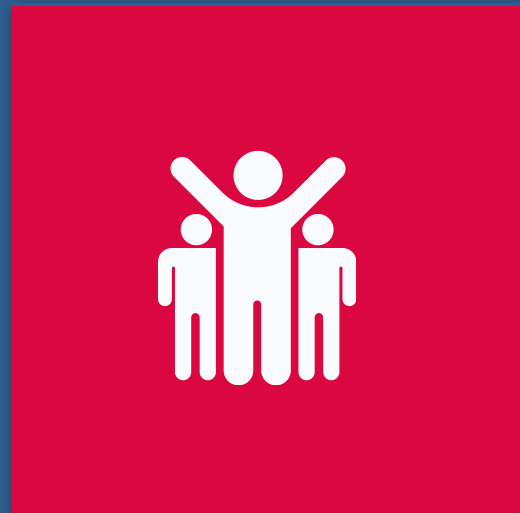
“The Fellow’s Corner” is an initiative of the PROEDUCAR area, specially designed for **interventional cardiologists in training who reside in Latin America**. This initiative aims to create a space for exchange where participants can share their clinical experiences and raise questions related to cases of interest in the field of cardiovascular intervention.

Through this project, collaborative learning is encouraged, allowing fellows to benefit from the experiences of their peers while receiving insights and guidance from professionals with extensive expertise and experience in different areas of interventional cardiology.

Cases submitted by participants will be published on SOLACI’s official website (www.solaci.org) and shared across institutional social media channels, thereby expanding the reach and visibility of contributions made by professionals in training. The cases generating the greatest debate will be presented during virtual meetings organized by PROEDUCAR.



Participation Requirements



The call is open to all professionals interested in sharing clinical cases they consider relevant or useful for discussion and collective learning. **Participation has no restrictions and is completely free of charge**, allowing anyone who wishes to contribute to do so without limitations.

It is important to note that **being a fellow is not a mandatory requirement to submit a clinical case**; any professional who believes their contribution may be interesting or educational is invited to participate in this initiative.



How to Submit Clinical Cases

Case submission is made through the “**Fellow’s Corner**” section on the SOLACI website (www.solaci.org)

The submission process is simple, fast, and fully online. Presentations may include images and videos. It will take no more than **5 minutes**.

01

Complete the form with personal information and case summary

Fill in your personal and institutional details and upload a photograph along with a brief case summary using the form available in the **Fellow’s Corner** section.

02

Prepare the presentation

Prepare your clinical case in digital format, following the suggested content structure and complying with the established submission formats and technical recommendations (see next page).

03

Upload the file

Once you have submitted the form with your personal information, click the “Submit your case” button to upload your presentation via a secure Dropbox link.

1. Completing the Form

Participants must complete the form on the SOLACI website including:

- Full name.
- Email address.
- Phone number (including international dialing code).
- Country and city of residence.
- Institution / Workplace.
- Name of the Head of Department.
- High-quality personal photograph.

Without this document, the application will not be considered complete.

2. Preparing the Presentation

One of the most frequently asked questions about the Fellow's Corner is how to properly structure the presentation for acceptance. Below you will find recommendations for preparing your clinical case.

Structure

- Presentation
- Multiple Choice Questions
- Case Resolution

A) Case Presentation

Must include:

- **Baseline clinical data** and relevant patient history
- **Brief clinical history** (relevant data)
- **Complementary studies** performed during evaluation and treatment
- **Representative images and/or videos**
- **Brief justification** explaining why the case is of interest or presents unique features

C) Case Resolution

Must detail:

- Therapeutic approach effectively adopted
- Justification of the decision
- Final patient evolution and clinical outcomes

B) Multiple Choice Questions

Include questions to promote reflection and discussion:

- **One question regarding the recommended management**, with multiple possible answer options
- **Multiple choice questions related to the intervention performed** (a single correct answer is not required)
- **A final question** asking whether the reader agrees with the case resolution

Accepted Formats

- PowerPoint (.ppt / .pptx).
- .zip file (recommended if including videos).

Technical Recommendations

- **Videos embedded in the presentation** or provided separately in MP4 format, clearly indicating insertion location
- Maximum file size: 2 GB
- **Suggested file name format:** LastName_Country_CaseTitle.pptx



3. Upload your file
